

2009-2010 WOODGLEN ELEMENTARY SUPPLY LIST

Kindergarten

- 1 box (24 ct.) crayons
- 1 pack **ELMER'S** glue sticks
- 2 plastic folders
- 1 box washable markers
- 1 pkg. #2 pencils – solid colors only - no fancy colors or designs
- 2 boxes of tissues
- 1 bottle liquid hand soap
- 1 standard size backpack (no wheels)
- Girls – 1 box gallon size Ziploc bags
- Boys – 1 box quart size Ziploc bags
- Optional – to be used at home for homework: scissors, glue, crayons, pencils
- *All supplies are shared.
- *Please label only backpacks & coats with student's full name. If your student attends the K.E.E.P. program and has a lunch box, please label that also.
- *Please keep all unapproved materials at home.

First Grade

- 1 box of 8 washable **CRAYOLA** brand original tipped Classic Color markers
- 2 boxes of 24 **CRAYOLA** brand crayons – basic colors (maintain supply)
- 24 #2 **Paper-mate** brand pencils (not mechanical – maintain supply) plain colors – for community supply
- 1 pair **FISKARS** pointed student scissors (sturdy, good quality)
- 2 bottles 4 oz. liquid white school glue (re-supply when needed)
- 1 pocket folder (plain solid color – bottom pockets only)
- 2 boxes of tissues – 250 count
- 1 clean sock
- Coins for math program: 20 pennies, 10 nickels, 10 dimes, 4 quarters – will be returned at the end of the year
- Regular sized backpack without wheels
- Last Name A-M – 1 box quart size Ziploc bags (20 ct. or more bags)
- Last name N-Z – 1 box gallon size Ziploc bags (20 ct. or more bags)
- Optional but appreciated – paper towel, 2 ply, heavy duty

Second Grade

- 1 **LARGE** box **CRAYOLA** crayons
- 1 box colored pencils
- 1 pink eraser
- 6 glue sticks
- 1 4 oz. bottle liquid white school glue
- 2 boxes of tissues
- 2 pencil bags – heavy duty – non vinyl (1 for pencils, 1 for crayons) - **NO BOXES**
- 36 #2 lead pencils – **sharpened** (not mechanical – maintain supply)
- 3 composition books – wide lined – no plastic covers (please bring 3 in August and 3 in January)
- 1 container anti-bacterial wipes

Third Grade

- 6 spiral notebooks – **WIDE LINED** (3/8" ruled)
- 1 ruler (inches & centimeters)
- 1 pair sharp pointed student scissors
- 2 pencil bags – **HEAVY DUTY** (vinyl bags don't usually last long) – 1 for pencils, 1 for crayons – **NO BOXES!**
- 1 set of colored pencils
- 24 #2 pencils – **PLEASE maintain supply throughout the year**
- 2 large boxes of tissues (one for each semester)
- 2 bottles of antibacterial **SOAP** (Not Gel) – Mrs. Borton only
- Coins for math games – put in Ziploc bag labeled with student's name: 25 pennies, 6 nickels, 6 dimes, 6 quarters (will be returned at the end of the school year)
- NO 3-RING NOTEBOOKS OR TRAPPER KEEPERS**

Fourth Grade

- 1 yellow highlighter marker
- 1 box washable markers OR 1 box 24 crayons
- #2 pencils – sharpened (keep supply maintained)
- Wide lined notebook paper (keep supply maintained)
- pens (red and blue or black)
- 4 pocket folders
- 2 large boxes of tissues
- NO** scented markers or pencils please. Also, **NO** 3-ring binders or Trapper Keepers.

Fifth Grade

- 1 solar-powered calculator (with a square root key)
- 1 pkg. wide lined notebook paper – **NOT** narrow or college rule
- 24 #2 pencils - sharpened
- 2 glue sticks
- 2 boxes of tissues
- 2 felt tip pens (any color)
- 1 highlighter (any color)
- Hard Plastic Transport Expandable File (6 dividers, letter size) or a Trapper Keeper with 6 folders
- *We will be collecting 22 of the pencils and the felt tip pens, tissues and the notebook paper to distribute on an as needed basis.
